- Genetic Testing
 - ➤ The genetic test for dwarfism has been officially validated, and is noted as a Known Condition in the Chinook breed. Thanks to everyone that participated in the testing. Dr. Jonas Donner, one of the head geneticists at Genoscoper, is preparing to publish this finding.
 - A Chinook has tested as a carrier for a mutation that causes glaucoma in Norwegian Elkhounds. Genoscoper is re-testing the dog to see if this was a false positive. If it checks out, they will expand testing to the dog's relatives. Genoscoper will continue research here.
 - ➤ There are now 100 Chinooks tested by Genoscoper, which means we will start to get breed prevalence reports on mutations and conditions.

The Committee is actively drafting the next generation CrossBreeding Program, a/k/a the CBCP.
