EVENTS/CLASSES

Licensed Conformation classes for UKC registered dogs consist of:

1. Regular Classes. Classes for intact dogs:

- Puppy (>=6 mos. < 1 year)
- Junior (>=1 yr.- < 2 yrs.)
- Intermediate (Senior) (>=2yrs. under 3 yrs.)
- Adult (>=3 yrs. and up)
- Breeder/Handler (>=6 mos. and up) handled by breeder or breeder's family)
- Champion; and Grand Champion

2. Altered Classes. For spayed/neutered dogs.

- Altered Puppy (>=6 mos. < 1 year)
- Altered Junior (>=1 yr. < 2 yrs.)
- Altered Intermediate (Senior) (>=2yrs. under 3 yrs.)
- Altered Adult (>=3 yrs. and up)
- Altered Breeder/Handler (>=6 mos. & up) handled by breeder or breeder's family)
- Altered Champion; and Altered Grand Champion

3. Junior Showmanship Classes. Consist of:

- Pee Wee (over 2 yrs., under 4 yrs.)
- Sub-Junior (4 yrs., under 8 yrs.)
- Novice Junior, Open Junior (8 yrs., under 13 yrs.)
- Novice Senior, Open Senior (13 yrs., under 18 yrs.)

Non-Licensed and Miscellaneous Classes consist of:

- 1. **Novice Puppy** for puppies (3 months-under 6 months)
- 2. Stud Dog /Brood Bitch open to Chinooks with 2-4 intact offspring at the show
- **3. Brace** open to intact Chinooks over 6 months old where a single exhibitor shows two dogs simultaneously to demonstrate consistent type and quality
- 4. Veteran Chinooks over 7, altered or intact

5. The COA Cross Specialty - open to COA registered Crossbred Chinooks

- Male –intact male COA Crosses
- Female –intact female COA Crosses
- Altered Male neutered male COA Crosses
- Altered Female spayed female COA Crosses



Special Events

The Chinook Owners Association holds three special events in conjunction with each Specialty.

- Parade of Title Holders Immediately after the conformation show, there will be a Parade of Titleholders
 for dogs deserving special recognition for their achievements. Along with other entry paperwork, owners
 should submit a paragraph noting the dog's accomplishments (showing, working, as family pet) that will be
 read aloud while the dog is recognized in the ring. This event will be open for PRE-ENTRY ONLY.
- 2. After the Parade of Titleholders, **the Chesterh Sweetie award** is bestowed each year in honor of Chester Holleran, who contributed so much to the COA over the years. The dog awarded the Chesterh Sweetie is the dog that displays the most affable, friendly and pleasant demeanor and is most attentive to the Chesterh Sweetie judge.
- 3. The Chinook Owners Association holds an **annual banquet the evening of the Specialty**. Our judge, Helena Engelauf will be speaking about the traits that she has seen in the show ring and considerations for the future of the Chinook breed. This year, the annual banquet will be held at:
