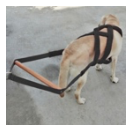

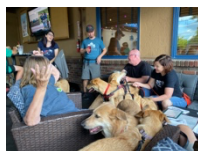

CLASSES AND ENTRY FEE BREAKDOWN

(From the 2019 UKC Official Conformation Rulebook, pg. 15-16 and the 2019 UKC Official Junior Rulebook, pg. 4)

Licensed Conformation (\$30 pre-entry (PE), \$35 day-of-show (DOS)), Junior Showmanship (\$30 PE and DOS) classes for UKC registered dogs consist of:

1. **Regular Classes for intact dogs** (The first five classes are called ‘class dogs’, for dogs just starting out that have not attained a Champion or Grand Champion title.)
 1. Puppy Male/Female. For dogs six (6) months of age and under one (1) year of age.
 2. Junior Male/Female. For dogs one (1) year of age and under two (2) years of age.
 3. Adult Male/Female. For dogs two (2) years of age and older.
 4. Open Male/Female. For dogs six (6) months of age or older. This is a ‘wildcard’ slot
 5. Breeder/Handler Male/Female. For dogs six (6) months of age or older. Dogs entered in this class must be handled by a breeder of record with UKC, or by a member of the immediate family of a breeder of record.
 6. Champion. For dogs of both sexes that have earned their UKC Champion title.
 7. Grand Champion. For dogs of both sexes that have earned their UKC Grand Champion title.
2. **Altered Classes for spayed/neutered dogs.** The above age/title/cost breakdowns apply.
3. **Junior Showmanship Classes.** Consist of:
 1. Pee Wee (over 2 yrs., under 4 yrs.)
 2. Sub-Junior (4 yrs., under 6 yrs.)
 3. Pre-Junior (6 yrs., under 8 yrs.)
 4. Novice Junior, Open Junior (8 yrs., under 13 yrs.)
 5. Novice Senior, Open Senior (13 yrs., under 18 yrs.)

Non-Licensed Conformation (\$30 PE and DOS/Class) classes consist of:

1. Novice Puppy – for puppies (3 months-under 6 months)
2. Stud Dog /Brood Bitch – open to Chinooks with 2-4 intact offspring at the show
3. Brace – open to intact Chinooks over 6 months old where a single exhibitor shows two dogs simultaneously to demonstrate consistent type and quality
4. Veteran – Chinooks over 7, altered or intact

Special Exhibitions (\$30 PE and \$35 DOS)

1. The COA Cross Specialty – open to COA registered Crossbred Chinooks
 1. Male –intact male COA Crosses
 2. Female –intact female COA Crosses
 3. Altered Male – neutered male COA Crosses
 4. Altered Female – spayed female COA Crosses
2. Parade of Title Holders – open for PRE-ENTRY ONLY for dogs deserving special recognition for their lifetime achievements. Owners should submit a paragraph noting the dog’s accomplishments (showing, working, as family pet) that will be read aloud while the dog is recognized in the ring. Please submit to our Show Secretary Diana Fowler. No charge!

Chesterh Sweetie Award - is awarded annually at the National Specialty to the “sweetest” Chinook or Chinook cross. A volunteer will judge the “sweetness” of all the participating dogs, and one award will be given to the dog judged the sweetest!

- **Ocala's National Forest** is a protected natural area in North Florida, near Ocala, known for its large sand pine scrub forest, over 600 natural springs like Juniper and Alexander Springs, and the Florida Trail Forest (dogs are allowed in most areas of the Forest, but they must be on a leash no longer than 6 feet; they are not allowed in the Springs): <https://www.ocalamarion.com/things-to-do/outdoors/ocala-national-forest/>
- Ocala Springs: there are many **natural springs** located in and around Ocala, most notably within the Ocala National Forest and Silver Springs State Park. These springs, such as Silver Springs, Juniper Springs, Alexander Springs, Silver Glen Springs, and Salt Springs, are renowned for their clear, warm water and offer activities like swimming, snorkeling, canoeing, and glass-bottom boat tours: <https://www.ocalamarion.com/blog/natural-springs-must-do-activities-in-marion-county/>
- If you travel with kids and want to do something real local, consider **ziplining in Ocala**: This Ocala Florida property is a rare gem! The terrain on this nearly 100 acres is spellbinding. Towering cliffs, sparkling lakes, old growth oak trees, massive canyons... and zip lines running through it all! Tours feature 9 zip lines, 2 rope bridges and a rappel. 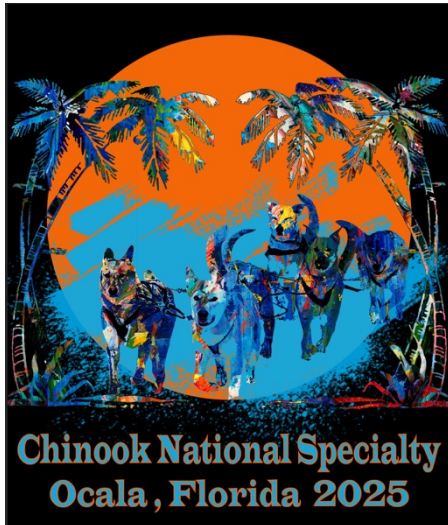
